Background

Blazemasters Fire Protection (BFP) LLC is a full-service company with expertise in the design, installation, and maintenance of fire-protection systems in commercial, industrial, and institutional structures. Since its founding in 1997, the company has grown from two to 39 employees, and has performed almost 100 jobs. Primary clients are in the federal/state, retail, and hospitality sectors. About 25 percent of its work comes from general contractors who have selected BFP six or even eight times. Revenue grew at a compounded rate of 30% from 2002-6, and 2007 growth to date exceeds that rate.

Position Description

- (1) Supervise a design staff of 10 mechanical engineers and engineering technicians in the production, internal review, stamping and client review/approval of system designs
- (2) Interface with staff of the general contractor, owner, A&E firms, and fire departments with respect to the design, installation, and testing of systems
- (3) Arrange for the production, review, and submission of QC, O&M, warranties, and as-built drawings for completed projects
- (4) Provide professional training and guidance to assist design staff with acquiring registration, certification, and other professional credentials

Key Duties

- (1) Work with sales and marketing staff and field installers to develop design budgets for proposals, and manage design staff to meet budgets, design intent, and local and national codes
- (2) Attend meetings, walk-throughs, and other project-related activities to explain and get support for conceptual designs, shop drawings, and other design-related products
- (3) Develop schedules and associated documentation for system tests and other required milestone activities

Experience, Credentials

- (1) Must be a registered Professional Engineer in Hawaii, and must be (or with BFP support, be prepared to become) a Full Member of the Society of Fire Protection Engineers
- (2) Must have a record of at least five years of progressively greater responsibility in the production of code-compliant plans and drawings
- (3) Must have been shown to be an effective trainer of design staff and a successful liaison with staff from clients and general contractors
- (4) Must have demonstrated effective support of management with regard to development of strategy, diversification opportunities, business development, and technology integration
- (5) Prefer five years of experience in fire-protection system design, installation oversight, and service support
